Call for Photo and Video Essays

Images are important sources for historical research. Today, they also play an increasingly important role in historiography because numerous photographic and film sources have been secured, collected, indexed, and made available to researchers in recent decades. Many of these sources have now been digitized and are available online. At the same time, 'visual history' has established itself as an important field of historical research. The visibility of history as much as the historicity of the visual have become crucial subjects of historiographical research and history teaching.
